PHOTO CAPTIONS: New Livingston Program Answers Essex County's Need for Behavioral and Mental Healthcare

Successful Open House Introduces Community to Cutting-Edge Mental Healthcare Programs

Livingston, N.J. (February 27, 2013) – The cost of untreated mental illness in New Jersey is \$4 billion annually, according to the NJ Association of Mental Health Agencies. The financial toll is found in non-psychiatric medical care, prisons, unemployment, substance abuse, shelters, lack of productivity, school interventions, and broken families. GenPsych PC has tackled this urgent issue head on and hosted a free open house to celebrate the opening of their new facility in Livingston, NJ on February 20, 2013.
